## Rep. Shankland Congratulates Rosholt School District and Stevens Point Christian Academy on Receiving School Safety Grants

MADISON - Today, Rosholt School District was awarded $\$ 62,223$ and Stevens Point Christian Academy received $\$ 19,944$ through the school safety grant program created by Wisconsin Act 143 . The funding will be used to help the school districts complete new safety and security plans, as well as other school security upgrades. With the addition of Rosholt School District, all of the public school districts within Assembly District 71 have now received funding through the school safety grant program.

In response, Rep. Katrina Shankland (D-Stevens Point) released the following statement:
