Rep. Shankland Issues Statement Regarding the Planned Release of Homeless Sex Offender in Stevens Point

STEVENS POINT—Following the news that Daniel Wachowiak is scheduled to be mandatorily released from incarceration into the community on extended supervision, where he will be supervised by a probation and parole officer, without secured housing, Rep. Katrina Shankland (D-Stevens Point) has issued the following statement:

“Like many residents of Stevens Point, I am concerned about the news that Daniel Wachowiak will be released on May 16, 2023 into extended supervision without secured housing. That’s why I have reached out to the Department of Corrections who told me that they are continuing to search for housing so he may be more readily monitored. My first priority is always ensuring the safety and well-being of everyone in our community, and I am committed to working with all local and state partners to ensure it.”
