Representative Angela Stroud Reflects on the 2025 State of the Tribes Address

ASHLAND, Wis. – Representative Angela Stroud (D-Ashland) will be at the Superior Public Library on Tuesday, March 25th from 5:30-700pm and White Winter Winery in Iron River on Thursday, March 27th from 6:30-8:00pm to provide updates from Madison, including highlighting some of the Governor’s recent budget proposal. There will be plenty of time for discussion and questions about all things politics and governance.

Representative Stroud released the following statement:
