Announcement of Speakers Taskforce on Racial Disparity Members

MADISON, WI- On October 21st, Assembly Speaker Robin Vos announced the 28 community leaders, and 2 additional legislators that will comprise the Taskforce on Racial Disparities. As Co-Chair of the Taskforce, Representative Stubbs (D-Madison) stated the following:

Over the last month my fellow Co-Chair, Rep.Steineke (R-Kaukauna), and I met with individuals who were interested in ending the racial disparities that exist in our state.
