## **Rep. Lisa Subeck Praises Dane County Court Ruling in Favor of Workers' Rights in Wisconsin**

MADISON – Today, a Dane County Judge struck down several provisions of Act 10, the 2011 law that placed crippling restrictions on public sector employee unions in Wisconsin.

Representative Lisa Subeck released the following statement in response:

“Act 10 was one of the most significant attacks on workers’ rights in Wisconsin history, and it continues to have devastating effects on our economy and the well-being of working families across our state.

This ruling is a decisive victory not only for Wisconsin public employees, but for all Wisconsinites who stand to benefit from a state government that treats its public servants with dignity and respect.”

Rep. Subeck has represented the 78th Assembly District since 2015 and serves as Chair of the Assembly Democratic Caucus.
