Rep. Considine, Assembly Democrats Announce Economic Opportunity Agenda

MADISON – Today Rep. Considine (D-Baraboo) and the Assembly Democrats announced their Economic Opportunity Agenda, a package of legislation that will help restore economic opportunity for Wisconsin workers, students and families.

"One of my top priorities as a legislator is to work to restore economic opportunity for the people of the 81st Assembly District and across Wisconsin," Rep. Considine said. "The bills my Democratic colleagues and I put forward today will help create sustainable, well-paying jobs and grow Wisconsin's middle class. I look forward to working on both sides of the aisle to advance these proposals and ensure they receive the strong bipartisan support they deserve."

Among the 15 bills announced today are several initiatives that would have a significant positive impact on the 81st Assembly District, including:

- Expanding access to rural broadband
- Indexing the Homestead Tax Credit for inflation
- Restoring full funding to the state's farm-to-school program

"Wisconsin continues to lag behind in job and wage growth and we are facing one of the largest budget deficits in the country," Rep. Considine stated. "It is more important than ever that we as elected officials work together to help our communities rebuild and connect with each other, in order to ensure better opportunities for our citizens. This is the agenda the people of Wisconsin have told us they want and I am ready to fight for their top priorities – good jobs, better wages and long-term economic security."
