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Bipartisan bill passes committee unanimously

Madison – This morning the Assembly Committee on Local Government unanimously passed Assembly Bill (AB) 253, relating to the sale of foreclosed properties. Among other things, AB 253 would clarify that published foreclosure sale notices must include the street address of the property and the sum of the judgment.

I’m proud to bring his voice to the table as a coauthor of this bill, and I’m grateful to the members of the committee for seeing its value and moving it forward in the legislative process,” said Rep.
