### **Keep the Bipartisan Bills Coming**

**Madison** – Today, the Assembly passed a number of bipartisan bills. Representative Dave Considine (D-Baraboo) issued the following statement on today’s Assembly floor session:

“Bipartisan bills are the product of working together and finding sound solutions. Today, I was happy to vote on many bipartisan bills, some of which were a result of study committees. These efforts are a positive step towards a better Wisconsin.

“We need to keep this bipartisan momentum going. I am proud to have introduced bipartisan legislation this session. One of these bills is Assembly Bill (AB) 889 which prohibits the use of a cell phone while driving in a school zone when children are present. I am encouraged that this bill has received a public hearing in the Senate, as this is an essential step in the legislative process.

“I also introduced AB 935 which allows the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to use their allocated funding for recycling to educate the public on recycling. This is another common-sense proposal that we need to get to the finish line. Education on recycling is essential in maintaining an efficient recycling system in the state.

“I am requesting that we bring AB 889, AB 935, and other bipartisan proposals to a vote in the Assembly.”
