Rep. Considine Statement on 2024 State of the Tribes Address

Madison – Today, Forest County Potawatomi Community Chairman James Crawford delivered the 2024 State of the Tribes address in the Assembly Chambers. Representative Dave Considine (D-Baraboo) issued the following statement on the State of the Tribes address:

"Chairman Crawford gave an impactful address before the Legislature today. He emphasized the importance of working together for the greater good, regardless of background. I could not agree more. We must continue to work with the governments of Wisconsin's sovereign tribal nations to create a shared vision for the future of our state.
