As Trump Crashes Our Economy, WI GOP Pulls Rug Out From Under Wisconsinites

MADISON - Today, the Wisconsin State Assembly met to vote on several unemployment bills. Representative Alex Joers (D-Waunakee) released the following statement:

“At a time when President Trump is making decisions daily that push our economy into chaos, Republican legislators have decided that the best use of our time is making it more difficult for our constituents to access unemployment benefits if they lose their jobs.
