Rep. Wichgers Supports Unifying Flags Bill

Madison – Today on the Assembly Floor, Rep. Chuck Wichgers spoke in support of Assembly Bill 58 – relating to flags that are flown, hung, or displayed from the State Capitol and State of Wisconsin and local government buildings.

Representative Wichgers released the following statement:

“The flags we fly are symbols of groups or ideas that people share. That can be difficult with wide differences between citizens. One thing Wisconsinites have in common is shared state residence and citizenship in the United States of America.

One of many things we do not have in common is a common religion. Neither do Wisconsinites share support of the homosexual lifestyle and transgender ideology. Many Wisconsinites believe we are not defined by our sexual identity, and that the welfare of children takes precedence over the sexual identities of adults. For the past four years, I have made press statements objecting to our governor flying the Pride flag and the Progress Pride flag for these reasons.

Assembly Bill 58 ensures the flags we fly over state buildings unite, and do not divide us. I was happy to vote for this bill today, and I urge the governor to stand with all Wisconsinites and sign it.”
