Representative Snyder Votes in Favor of Middle Class Tax Cuts

Rep. Snyder votes yes on cutting taxes for middle class by \$340 million

Madison... Representative Patrick Snyder (Schofield) voted on Tuesday in support of cutting taxes for middle class families by \$340 million. Subsequently, Rep. Snyder made the following statement:

“Hard-working, middle class families deserve a break; this legislation delivers that. Through prudent fiscal management, we have a budget surplus, which belongs back in the pockets of hard-working Wisconsinites. Over 2 million filers will be positively impacted by this legislation.”

The legislation, Assembly Bill 4, will reduce taxes for individuals making less than \$100,000 and families making less than \$150,000 by increasing the standard deduction. According to the nonpartisan Legislative Fiscal Bureau, a median income family filing jointly would see a \$310 reduction in net taxes, which equates to a 10.5% reduction in their tax liability.

“Rather than shifting the tax burden onto our largest economic drivers, manufacturers and farmers, we are putting money back in the pockets of our middle income earners, without burdening our job creators.”

Assembly Bill 4 passed the Assembly 61-33. It now heads to the State Senate for approval, before being sent to Governor Evers’ desk. If signed into law, the legislation will go into effect in tax year 2020.
