## **Rep. Edming's Epinephrine Auto-Injector Bill Passes Committee Vote**

**Madison** – Today, legislation authored by Representative James W. Edming (R-Glen Flora) passed the Assembly Committee on Health with a vote of 12-0. Assembly Bill 203 would allow epinephrine auto-injectors to be stored in public places where an individual could come in contact with an allergen.

“I was happy to work across the aisle to enhance this bill through the amendment process,” said Rep. Edming. “It was great to see strong bipartisan support in the committee and I would like to thank the committee members for their commitment to keeping Wisconsinites safe.”

“Allergies are on the rise in our state and this bill will help keep people safe during anaphylaxis,” said Rep. Edming. “I believe that members of the Committee on Health recognized the importance of creating greater access to these life-saving epinephrine auto-injectors and as a result, supported this legislation.”

Assembly Bill 203 will now come before the State Assembly next week.
