Rep. Edming's Red Tape Review Bill Signed into Law

Madison – Governor Scott Walker signed Assembly Bill 158 into law today. The bill was authored by Representative James W. Edming (R-Glen Flora) and Senator Jerry Petrowski (R-Marathon) and received unanimous support in both the Assembly and Senate.

“I am pleased that this law eliminates Department of Natural Resources code that has not been utilized in 25 years,” said Rep. Edming. “These changes reflect the Red Tape Review’s goal of removing outdated regulations. We must ensure that rules are current and still serve a purpose.”

Since 1990, pollution and sewer overflow abatement projects have been funded through the clean water fund program and financial assistance to wastewater treatment systems has been administered by the Department of Safety and Professional Services. Prior to 1990, the Department of Natural Resources had jurisdiction over these programs and corresponding agency administrative rules still exist. This law eliminates the obsolete Department of Natural Resources administrative code.
