Rep. Edming's Epinephrine Auto-Injector Bill Signed into Law

Madison – Governor Scott Walker signed Senate Bill 139 into law today. The bill was authored by Representative James W. Edming (R-Glen Flora) and Senator Leah Vukmir (R-Wauwatosa) and received wide bipartisan support in both the Senate and Assembly.

"I am pleased that this law will allow more access to epinephrine auto-injectors," said Rep. Edming. "Allergies are on the rise, so it is crucial to ensure that individuals have access to these lifesaving devices during an anaphylactic reaction. This law will help save lives in Wisconsin."

2015 Wisconsin Act 35 allows public places, other than schools, to store epinephrine auto-injectors for treatment during anaphylaxis. It is also Representative Edming's first piece of legislation to be signed into law.
