Rep. Spaude Applauds Governor Evers' State of the State Address

MADISON – Last night, Governor Tony Evers delivered his State of the State Address in the Wisconsin State Capitol, where he laid out his vision for the next year.

Representative Spaude (D-Ashwaubenon) released the following statement:
