Rep. Ryan Spaude Sworn in for the 2025-2026 Legislative Session

MADISON, Wis. — Rep. Ryan Spaude (D-Ashwaubenon) was sworn in today at the State Capitol as the State Representative for the 89th Assembly District. Rep. Spaude will serve on the Criminal Justice and Public Safety and Tourism committees for the duration of the 2025-2026 session of the legislature.

Following the ceremony, Rep. Spaude released the following statement:
