How to Express Your Thoughts on the State Budget

In the last couple months since Governor Evers announced his budget, offices throughout the Capitol have been combing through the large document and its additional texts. My goal with this budget is to ensure that tax payer dollars are being spent wisely and are helping out our local rural communities.

Governor Evers' budget has been referred to the Joint Committee on Finance, which has bipartisan membership with sixteen members from both the Assembly and Senate. The Joint Committee on Finance is currently taking testimonies from agencies throughout state in regard to the biennial budget recommendations by the Governor.

The summary of the budget has already been released, so now the committee will be holding public hearings on the Governor's proposed budget in the next couple of weeks across the State of Wisconsin. After the public hearings are held, the Joint Finance will hold their executive sessions to review the recommendations further.

There are multiple public hearings across the state that the Joint Committee on Finance has scheduled, one of which is near the 92nd district at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls. The public hearing will be held on Monday, April 15th at 10 a.m. in the University Center-Riverview Ballroom #260 located at 500 Wild Rose Avenue, River Falls, WI. All people interested in voicing their opinions are welcome to attend.

The public hearings held by the Joint Committee on Finance is a great way for you to speak and ask questions about the budget recommendations that the Governor has proposed. I urge you to go to the public hearing at University of Wisconsin-River Falls to voice your concerns directly to members of the bipartisan committee.

In addition, our Spring Survey will be sent out soon for the constituents of the 92nd district to be able to provide feedback in regard to the budget and how we are doing.
