As we move further into the summer months, there are going to be more people traveling on the roads going to sporting events, on vacations, attending car shows, or simply enjoying the great weather with their family and friends. Because of all this, I thought it might be helpful to provide the 92^{nd} with an update on some construction projects and how to stay safe.

In Buffalo County, there is a project that should be in the final stages on Wisconsin 121 from Gilmanton to Independence. Jackson County has two road projects including Wisconsin 54 from Black River Falls to City Point and the second is on 1-94 from Black River Falls where you should expect delays. In addition, Trempealeau County has three major road construction projects happening on I-94 from Eau Claire to Osseo, on US 53 at Beaches Corner, and on County Road D from Ettrick to Wisconsin 95.

When traveling through construction zones, please be careful and pay attention. There have been many accidents as a result of not paying attention in work zones that have been fatal. I know that sometimes you want to change the radio station, have a bite to eat, or text back that friend about your plans, but it is important to always pay attention while driving. As firefighter I have seen too many accidents and the devastation that a moment of distraction can cause.

Be sure to be safe and respectful while traveling and remember that there may be delays in getting from point a to point b.
