## Rep. Pronschinske Provides Statement on COVID-19

**Madison** – Representative Treig E. Pronschinske (R-Mondovi) released the following statement in regards to rising cases of COVID-19 in Western Wisconsin:

“Since March this pandemic has affected us in many ways including in our finances, education, businesses, mentally and most importantly in our physical health. While COVID-19 continues to be a present danger in our communities, I highly recommend people do what is best for them and their families while being smart and staying safe,” Rep. Pronschinske stated.

Rep. Pronschinske added, “While each death is a travesty, thankfully our district has seen lower rates of death from the coronavirus than other areas of the state. As of November 12<sup>th</sup>, Buffalo County has had three recorded deaths, Jackson County has had two recorded deaths and Trempealeau County has had seven recorded deaths.”

“While the cases throughout the state continue to rise, I firmly believe we will come out of this pandemic as a closer knit community and will be able to rebuild our economy. If you or a loved one are currently experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 I encourage you to get tested and to isolate from vulnerable family and community members,” Rep. Pronschinske continued.
