Representative Moses Supports Voter ID

Madison... State Representative Clint Moses (R-Menomonie) voted in favor of <u>Senate Joint Resolution 2</u> that aims to amend the State Constitution to require voters show a Voter ID when casting a ballot in any election.

"Voter ID is a common sense way to protect and secure our elections with over 80% of people believing in this law," said Representative Moses. "This is why after today's vote folks with have a chance to weigh in on this important measure to add it to the Wisconsin Constitution on their April ballot."

To amend the state constitution, a proposal must pass both the Assembly and Senate in two subsequent sessions and then be approved in a statewide election. Representative Moses co-authored and voted in favor of the Voter ID resolution in both sessions. The resolution now goes directly to the voters for their approval on a statewide ballot in April 2025.

"In recent years, election integrity has been a concern for many people. We have seen more people voting in elections than 10 years ago," explained Representative Moses. "I am confident that Wisconsinites will overwhelmingly approve Voter ID in April."
