## Rep. Moses Votes to Protect the Wisconsin Consumer

Madison – Rep. Clint Moses (R-Menomonie) voted in favor of legislation prohibiting state and local governments in Wisconsin from banning the sales or use of products based on their energy source.

The state of California has banned the sale of new vehicles with gas-powered engines by 2035, with other states already making the same commitment. Minnesota has proposed banning gas stoves and lawn mowers. Local governments across the country have also introduced bans on gas-powered devices.

AB 141 prohibits state and local governments from restricting the sale or use of an item based on its source of energy.

AB 142 prohibits state agencies and local governments from banning the use or sale of motor vehicles based on their energy source. This measure isn't limited to only gas, it includes electric vehicles as well.

"Whether you choose gas or electric is a consumer choice, not one that should be mandated by the government," said Rep. Moses. "We need to preserve the free market, ensure consumer access to reliable products and protect consumers and manufacturers from government bureaucrats."

The bills now head to the state Senate for consideration.
