Rep. Moses Votes for Public Safety Bills

Madison – Rep. Clint Moses (R-Menomonie) joined his Assembly colleagues in passing legislation that aims to increase public safety.

"The initiatives we passed today not only address the growing violent crime problem but also establish a new level of accountability," said Rep. Moses. "We need to enforce the gun laws that are on the books. It's time to make our communities safe from gun violence."

Included in the package of bills are reforms that double penalties for reckless driving, create a mandatory minimum sentence for violent felons in possession of a firearm, provide transparency on individuals that have been granted, denied, or had their parole revoked, and define "violent crime" and "serious harm" for the bail constitutional amendment on the ballot on April 4th.

"Reckless drivers and felons with illegal firearms need to be prosecuted to the fullest extent." said Rep. Moses. "These bills will make Wisconsin families safer."

Rates of violent crime, murder, and aggravated assault in Wisconsin are at the <u>highest level in</u> over 35 years. "Wisconsin needs to step up and take action," said Rep. Moses.
