## **2019 BILL**

1 AN ACT *to amend* 20.370 (1) (mu); and *to create* 29.063 (7) of the statutes; 2 **relating to:** deer carcass disposal sites, chronic wasting disease education, and 3 making an appropriation.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the Department of Natural Resources to provide large metal containers where hunters may dispose of deer carcasses, to be placed in locations throughout the state as determined by DNR. The bill provides in the 2019–21 fiscal biennium \$2,000,000 for the carcass disposal sites. The bill also provides in the 2019–21 fiscal biennium \$100,000 for DNR to provide education to hunters about chronic wasting disease and the importance of proper carcass disposal.

8 **SECTION 2.** 29.063 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

9 29.063 (7) The department shall provide large metal containers where hunters 10 may dispose of deer carcasses in locations throughout the state as determined by the 11 department. The department shall regularly dispose of any carcasses placed in the 12 containers.

## **SECTION 3. Fiscal changes.**

the dollar amount for fiscal year 2019-20 is increased by \$50,000 to provide
education to hunters about chronic wasting disease and the importance of proper
