Rep. Billings Statement on Governor Evers' 2024 State of the State Address

Madison, Wis – Tonight Governor Tony Evers gave his 2024 State of the State Address. Upon the conclusion of his address Rep. Billings released the following statement.

"Tonight Governor Evers highlighted the accomplishments of his administration, the challenges that we face as a state moving forward, and opportunities to work together, across party-lines, to address the pressing issues facing families and communities across the state.

"As the Legislature finishes its Session, there is still time to address these challenges and invest in areas that will most benefit our constituents, our local economies, and our entire State, including investments in our children, our public education, and our workforce.
