Assembly Approves Child Care Reforms and Iowa-Style Nonpartisan Redistricting

Assembly Republicans on Thursday approved a package of bills designed to make child care more affordable for families and child care providers. The Assembly also approved a nonpartisan redistricting plan almost identical to Iowa.

The multi-pronged child care package modifies teacher-child ratios to be more in line with neighboring states. One of the bills would permit families across Wisconsin to use tax-advantaged savings accounts to pay for childcare. That bill was modeled after Flex Savings Accounts offered to state employees.

"These bills go a long way to solving child care staffing problems while keeping kids safe," said Rep. Cindi Duchow (R-Delafield). "We're empowering families and providers to make choices that best suit their families and businesses. Throwing taxpayer money at a problem and wishing it away is no way to govern."

Assembly Republicans also approved Iowa-style, nonpartisan redistricting model that legislative Democrats have been requesting for years.

"Wisconsin voters want a less confrontational process like 'the lowa Model' for state legislative mapmaking," said Rep. Duchow. "Regardless of political affiliation, we can come together and agree that it is right for Wisconsin."

Rep. Duchow represents the 99th Assembly District, which includes the villages of Lac La Belle, Chenequa, Hartland, Merton, Nashotah, Oconomowoc Lake, Wales, and portions of the village of Summit; the towns of Delafield, Merton, Oconomowoc, and portions of the town of Lisbon; and the City of Delafield.
