TRANSPORTATION -- MOTOR VEHICLES

Study of Economic and Safety Effects of Providing Driver License and Identification Cards to Undocumented Persons

Motion:

Require DOT, in conjunction with DWD, to study of the economic and safety effects of providing driver licenses and identification cards to undocumented persons. In completing this study, require the following:

(a) that the agencies consult with representatives from the economic sectors dependent on immigrant labor and law enforcement;

(b) that the agencies contract with national and non-partisan immigration, workforce development, and transportation safety experts, as well as public policy advocates, to produce a report that provides recommendations for potential modifications to Wisconsin driver licensing and identification card laws;

(c) that this report include a comparison of interstate driver licensing and identification card laws as they pertain to undocumented persons;

(d) that this report include analysis related to the costs and benefits of such laws; and

(e) that the agencies complete all elements of this study and submit the related report to the Legislature and the Governor by July 1, 2020.
