NATURAL RESOURCES -- CONSERVATION AND RECREATION

Omnibus Motion
[LFB Papers #515 through 523]

Motion:

Move to adopt the following provisions:

1. *Stewardship Extension (Paper #515)*. Adopt Alternative 2, which would reauthorize the stewardship program through June 30, 2030, at current annual program funding levels of \$33.25 million. The alternative would allow the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to use \$23.9 million in unobligated bonding authority under s. 20.866(2)(ta) in fiscal year 2020-21 and provide \$308.6 million in new bonding authority.

2. *Parks Staffing and Operations (Paper #516)*. Adopt Alternatives A1, B1, and C1, which would approve the Governor's recommendation to increase total parks and southern forest operations expenditures by \$1,431,200 annually, mostly from the parks account of the segregated (SEG) conservation fund. Alternative A1 would increase funding for limited-term employee (LTE) salaries and associated fringe costs by \$931,200 SEG annually. Alternative B1 would increase funding for supplies and services by \$350,000 SEG annually. Alternative C1 would increase funding for electrical services for newly electrified campsites by \$150,000 SEG annually.

3. *Law Enforcement Radios (Paper #517)*. Adopt Alternative 1, which would approve the Governor's recommendation to provide \$53,500 GPR, \$80,200 environmental SEG, and \$1,154,600 conservation SEG annually to fund the first two years of a four-year master lease for the acquisition of DNR Bureau of Law Enforcement radios.

4. *Remove Tribal Gaming Revenues from Snowmobile Enforcement*. Adopt the Governor's proposal to replace \$1,232,200 tribal gaming PR with an equivalent amount of GPR in each year of the biennium. Repeal the tribal gaming PR appropriation and create a GPR appropriation.

5. *Forest Fire Protection Grants (Paper #519)*. Adopt Alternative 1, which would approve the Governor's recommendation to provide \$278,000 forestry SEG (conservation fund) annually to increase funding for forest fire protection grants.

6. *Wisconsin Forest Practices Study (Paper #520)*. Adopt Alternative 1, which would approve the Governor's recommendation to provide \$225,000 forestry SEG annually to implement the recommendations of the forest practices study.

7. *Automatic Renewal for Hunting, Fishing, and Trapping Licenses.* Authorize DNR to develop an automatic renewal system for certain hunting, fishing, and trapping licenses, excluding conservation patron licenses. Authorize DNR to contract with a third party to store customer information to carry out the system.

8. *Off-Highway Motorcycles (Paper #522).* Adopt Alternative 1 to repeal s. 20.370 (9)(jb) of the statutes pertaining to OHM regulations and project aids. Create a new conservation SEG continuing OHM appropriation funded by a GPR transfer based on OHM registrations as calculated under current law, and appropriated for the same purposes as provided by s. 20.370 (9)(jb). Reestimate the transfer at \$60,100 each year in the 2019-21 biennium.

9. *County Forest Grants (Paper #523).* Adopt Alternatives A1 and B1, which would approve the Governor's recommendation to provide \$165,000 forestry SEG to increase funding available for county forest grants.
