## WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

### Omnibus Motion

Motion:

Move to adopt the following items:

#### Departmentwide and Vocational Rehabilitation

1. *Federal Reestimates.* Increase estimated federal funding by \$26,066,800 in 2023-24 and \$14,743,100 in 2024-25. The adjustments are to align expenditure authority with the amount of revenue that DWD estimates will be deposited into those appropriations. The adjustments would affect the following federal appropriations:

#### Employment and Training

2. *Fast Forward [Paper #870].* Adopt Alternative A1 to provide \$1,000,000 GPR annually for the Department's workforce training grants annual appropriation.

3. *Study Requirement.* Require the Department to retain an economist to study the economic benefit to the State of having paid family leave accessible to citizens compared to the economic loss of the out-migration of families from Wisconsin to Illinois, Michigan and Minnesota since 2019 who do not have access to paid family leave

#### Equal Rights and Employment Regulation

4. *Substance Abuse Prevention on Public Works Projects [Paper #880].* Adopt Alternative 1 to provide \$214,700 GPR in 2023-24 and \$286,200 GPR in 2024-25 and 3.0 GPR positions beginning in 2023-24 to the Department's general program operations appropriation for the administration and enforcement of a substance abuse prevention program.
