Rep. Stuck's Statement on Governor's Budget Address

Governor Evers Puts Forward Budget Based on Public Input not Backroom Deal

MADISON – Representative Amanda Stuck issued the following statement in response to Governor Tony Evers' Budget address:

"I look forward to reading and digesting Governor Evers' Budget in full, but preliminary reports show a drastically different budget than we have seen in recent years under the previous administration, where we saw budget strategies relying on math tricks to get to a balanced budget and putting forward policies to divide our communities instead of uniting them.

"The Governor's budget looks to prioritize public education, the UW System, criminal justice reform, conserving our environment, and ensuring access to clean water to communities both urban and rural parts of the state. The budget looks to invest in areas which will benefit and help to improve the lives of people across the state.

"I look forward to working with Governor Evers and Legislators on both sides of the aisle to ensure the passage of a budget which is based on common sense and compromise, which puts the interests of the public first."
