Dear Colleagues,

We are writing to you regarding AB643, which is on the proposed calendar for this Thursday, January, 28th. AB643 and its Senate companion, SB440, would require counties and municipalities to waive their federal recovery bonding authority so as to create a larger pool of funding that viable economic development projects in the state can draw from.

This bill passed out of the Assembly Committee on Jobs, the Economy and Small Business by a vote of 10 to 3. It is very important to take up and pass this bill in a timely manner to ensure the project with Energy Composites Corporation in Central Wisconsin can move forward. We have been told that this project will create 600 jobs in the state, with the potential to grow to 1000.

Attached is a letter from the bond counsel attorney for the project. The letter explains the project and why AB643 is necessary for it and of crucial importance for other projects across the state. Please review this information and if you have any questions let us know.
