When you come to the VITA site, be prepared. Be sure to bring following documentation for:

- Valid Photo ID
- Social Security cards and birth dates for you, your spouse, and any children on your return
- Last year's State & Federal tax returns
- Wage and earning statement(s) Forms W-2, W-2G or 1099-R from all employers
- Interest & dividend statements from banks (Form 1099)
- Unemployment compensation (Form 1099-G)
- Last year's VITA Tax envelope (if available)
- Bank routing information or blank check

If any of the following apply to you, please bring the following information:

- Childcare expenses, with provider's address & Social Security Number or Employer's Identification Number
- Rent Certificate signed by landlord or 2013 property tax bill
- Any notices received from the IRS or Wisconsin Dept. of Revenue
- College tuition & student loan interest statements (FAFSA)
- Alimony paid or received
- Adoption expenses
