Dear Republican Leaders,

On behalf of thousands of Wisconsinites, we are calling on you to schedule Senate Bill 365/Assembly Bill 366, otherwise referred to as the <u>*Right to Contraception Act*</u>, for a floor vote before the 2023-24 legislative session concludes this spring.

When Roe v. Wade was overturned, an individual's constitutional right to abortion was rejected, and rights that people have long enjoyed like their ability to access contraceptives, were put in jeopardy.

As you know, the *Right to Contraception Act* would protect Wisconsinites' right to access contraception and prevent the government from interfering in these personal healthcare decisions. We believe that passing the *Right to Contraception Act* this session is imperative to provide Wisconsinites with the assurance that this freedom remains intact.

With the continued onslaught of reproductive freedoms throughout the nation, including the Alabama Supreme Court's shocking ruling on frozen embryos, we ask that you reconsider your previous "no" vote on this proposal. It is clear that extremist attacks on reproductive freedom are reaching far beyond abortion access. Together we can assure Wisconsinites that decisions about their body and their health remain in their hands while ensuring that our laws honor those personal liberties.
