


Dear Governor Walker,

We write today to respectfully request that you retain the provisions in the 2013-2015 budget bill relating to Income Maintenance (IM) programs in Kenosha County. Specifically, we urge you not to veto in part or whole any portion that relates to Income Maintenance funds for Kenosha County. These provisions can be found in sections 350g, 350h, and 9418(10c) of engrossed 2013 Assembly Bill 40.

This budget provision is absolutely critical to Kenosha County and its inclusion is the result of cooperative efforts between Kenosha County officials, the Department of Health Services and the Kenosha County legislative delegation. Supplementing Kenosha County's IM funding through the bill ensures equity with other counties and allows the continuation of Kenosha County's exemplary service delivery system to the benefit of many IM families.
