The program offers a unique opportunity for lawmakers to improve their leadership skills and explore the issues of the day with nationally renowned scholars, professional development experts, and legislative leaders and colleagues from across the region.

**APPLYING FOR A FELLOWSHIP** Midwestern legislators in their first four years of legislative service are encouraged to apply. Fellowships are awarded based on an applicant's ability to demonstrate leadership potential, dedication to public service, and commitment to the legislative process and institution. Through the competitive application process, fellowships are awarded to Midwestern lawmakers from the Midwestern states of Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Saskatchewan, South Dakota, and Wisconsin.

Each fellowship covers the cost of tuition, lodging and meals related to attending the five-day Institute. Fellows are also eligible for a travel stipend to help cover a portion of their travel costs.
