## **Senator Habush Sinykin Reacts to Governor Evers’ Proposed Budget**

MADISON, WI – This evening, Senator Habush Sinykin (D-Whitefish Bay) attended Governor Tony Evers’ fourth Budget Address, which included historic investments for Wisconsin families and children. Most notably, Governor Evers proposed nearly \$2 billion in targeted tax relief through comprehensive planning and strategic efforts, while making continued investments in our schools and supporting local services and communities.

Senator Habush Sinykin released the following statement praising the Governor’s priorities:
