WISCONSIN'S 12TH SENATE DISTRICT

2ND AMENDMENT SANCTUARY STATE BILL HEADS TO GOVERNOR

On Wednesday, the Wisconsin State Senate passed my 2nd Amendment Sanctuary State legislation. It will now be sent to Governor Evers' desk, where he will have the option to sign it into law.

This bill gives assurances to ALL law-abiding Wisconsin gun owners, on both sides of the aisle, that their 2nd Amendment rights will not be infringed upon by radical government actors in Washington D.C.

The bill would prohibit any Wisconsin entity or person from enforcing a federal act, law, statute, rule, regulation, treaty, or order that takes effect after January 21, 2021 and does any of the following: bans any firearms, weapons, or magazines; requires registration for firearms, magazines, or firearm accessories; regulates the capacity of magazines; regulates the quantity of ammunition or bullets one may possess; prohibits a type of ammunition; or requires the confiscation of a firearm.

As we approach the 245th birthday of the United States of America, there is no better time to look back and reflect on who we are and how we got here. We are the greatest country in the world, with freedoms for every man and woman enshrined in our Constitution. Only after raising an army to defeat an tyrannical oppressor were we as a nation able to establish protections to make sure we never find ourselves in that situation again. Given our country's history, it is sheer lunacy that people in Washington D.C. openly discuss stripping the rights of legal gun owners throughout our country.

In addition to the 2nd Amendment Sanctuary State bill, the Senate took up a number of other bills:

<u>SB76</u>: Relating to: distribution of the aid payment for personal property upon termination of a tax incremental district.

SB191: Relating to: the authority to shoot a beaver or muskrat causing damage to a highway.

SB268: Relating to: compensation of election officials performing duties during a recount. **SB270**: Relating to: discontinuance of certain special group plates

<u>SB311</u>: Relating to: traffic violations when emergency or roadside response vehicles are present and providing a penalty.

SB352: Relating to: manufacturing, distributing, or delivering fentanyl or fentanyl analogs and providing a penalty.

SB384: Relating to: school district membership in an interscholastic athletic association in the 2021-22 school year.

SB386: Relating to: settlement of the multidistrict opiate litigation.

AB121: Relating to: practicing hair braiding without a license.

AB369: Relating to: timeline for local redistricting in Wisconsin following the 2020 federal decennial census.


These grants, presented by the Department of Tourism, will help with the promotion of the tourism industry throughout the Northwoods!
