Madison... Senator Joan Ballweg (R-Markesan) has been appointed to serve as Co-Chair for the Children, Families and Human Services Committee commissioned by the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL).

Senator Joan Ballweg will co-chair NCSL's committee on Children, Families and Human Services with Oregon State Representative Lisa Reynolds (D). Ballweg's appointment to the national committee is a two-year term. Throughout her time on the committee, Senator Ballweg will have the opportunity to participate in NSCL events, serve as a speaker or moderator for committee proceedings, connect with other legislators from across the nation and share information about policies implemented in Wisconsin.

Recently, Senator Ballweg's proposal to expand kinship care placements to those who are 'like-kin' was passed by both houses of the state legislature.
