Rep. Considine, Rep. Spreitzer Disappointed in JFC's Opposition to Fair Redistricting

Madison – Today, the Legislature's Joint Finance Committee voted along party lines against a budget motion that would have created a nonpartisan redistricting process in Wisconsin. Representatives Dave Considine (D-Baraboo) and Mark Spreitzer (D-Beloit) released the following statement in response to the vote:

"As co-chairs of the Assembly Democratic freshman caucus, we have been working hard with our freshman colleagues on nonpartisan redistricting legislation very similar to this budget motion. We were extremely disappointed to see that so many members of the Joint Finance Committee were unwilling to even consider a motion to make our state's legislative districts fair and balanced. We will continue to work to make nonpartisan redistricting a reality, and we sincerely hope our Republican colleagues will join us in these efforts."
