## Rep. Spreitzer passes Rock River Trail resolution

MADISON – On May 10<sup>th</sup>, the Wisconsin State Assembly passed a bipartisan resolution, Senate Joint Resolution 44, recognizing the grand opening of Rock River Trail and honoring the efforts of trail founder Frank Schier. Following passage, Rep. Mark Spreitzer (D-Beloit) issued the following statement:

"The Rock River Trail is a true Wisconsin treasure. The 11 Wisconsin counties and 41 communities along the Rock River will see benefits from both the recreational activities and economic development this trail will bring. I am proud to be an author of this resolution commemorating the Rock River Trail and look forward to its opening."
