## Rep. Mark Spreitzer Sworn In For a Third Term

MADISON- Today, State Representative Mark Spreitzer (D-Beloit) was inaugurated as the State Representative for the 45<sup>th</sup> Assembly District in the 2019-20 Wisconsin Legislature. He released the following statement regarding the honor:

"The voters made their voice loud and clear in November, and I am honored that the citizens of the 45<sup>th</sup> Assembly District have re-elected me as their representative. My colleagues in the Democratic Caucus and I will continue to work hard every day to champion the priorities that will put the people of our state first and fight for the values that will move Wisconsin forward.

Spreitzer served as Beloit City Council President, and worked for his alma mater, Beloit College. The 45th Assembly District includes portions of Rock and Green counties, and includes the communities of Brodhead, Albany, Evansville, Orfordville, Juda, and Beloit.
