**Rep. Mark Spreitzer Statement on Governor Evers’s Action on the State Budget**

MADISON – Today, following Governor Evers’s action on the 2021-2023 state budget, Rep. Mark Spreitzer (D-Beloit) released the following statement:

“I voted against this budget because it presented a false choice between investing in classrooms and students, and providing tax relief for hardworking families. I am glad that Governor Evers was able to use his veto pen and sound fiscal management to fix several key problems.

‘Among other improvements, Governor Evers is putting \$100 million more into public school classrooms while still delivering on his promise of tax cuts for middle-class families.

“Governor Evers’s partial vetoes also leave money available for the legislature to return and address other missed opportunities in this budget, like further investing in healthcare, child care, education, agriculture, criminal justice reform, and environmental protection.”
