Wisconsin State Parks Open May 1st

Wisconsin State Park properties are open to the public. Some properties will have limited admission based on capacity while others will remain closed due to the inability to adequately social distance. Portions of properties or high-density attractions may be closed to avoid overcrowding.

State parks, southern forests and recreation areas will be open 6am to 7pm and will be closed on Wednesdays.

**Northern forests, flowages and the Lower Wisconsin State Riverway will be open 6am to 11pm seven days a week.
