**2019 BILL**

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 20.455 (2) (cp) and 165.989 of the statutes; **relating to:**  
2             community-oriented policing house grant program and making an  
3             appropriation.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill establishes a \$600,000 grant program, administered by the Department of Justice, for cities with a population of 60,000 or more to fund community-oriented policing house programs.

5 **SECTION 2.** 20.455 (2) (cp) of the statutes is created to read:6 20.455 (2) (cp) *Community-oriented policing house grant program.* The  
7 amounts in the schedule to provide grants to cities under s. 165.989.8 **SECTION 3.** 165.989 of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act 59, is  
9 created to read:10 **165.989 Community-oriented policing house grant program.** (1) From  
11 the appropriation under s. 20.455 (2) (cp), the department of justice shall award  
12 grants to cities to fund community-oriented policing house programs.13 (2) A city is eligible for a grant under sub. (1) if the city has a population of  
14 60,000 or more.15 (3) The department of justice shall develop criteria which, notwithstanding s.  
16 227.10 (1), need not be promulgated as rules under ch. 227, for use in awarding  
17 grants under sub. (1).
