Evers Vetoes Middle Class Tax Cut for Third Time

Senator Van Wanggaard today released the following statement after Governor Evers vetoed billions in tax cuts despite having a \$3 billion surplus:

“Tony Evers won't take yes for an answer.

“Governor Evers has said repeatedly, even today in his veto message, that he supports a tax cut on people earning less than \$150,000.

“Three times he has vetoed a tax cut for those families. Three times he said that people who earn \$30,000 a year - those who qualify for food stamps- don't deserve a tax cut. Three times he said a teacher or plumber making \$60,000 a year doesn't deserve a tax cut. Three times he said a family making a combined \$100,000 a year struggling with inflation and child care doesn't deserve a tax cut.

“And today, he added that seniors on a fixed income and married couples don't deserve a tax cut.

“Voters and taxpayers need to ask themselves if Evers & Democrats really want a middle class tax cut. Because there's a term for people who say they want to do something and when given the opportunity to make it happen, they refuse. It begins with an ‘L.’”
