Central Wisconsin's KI Mobility Nominated for Recognition

Sen. Patrick Testin Nominates Revolutionary Wheelchair as "Coolest Thing Made in Wisconsin"

Stevens Point, WI – Wisconsin Manufacturers and Commerce (WMC), the state's chamber of commerce, is currently accepting nominations for their 5th annual "Coolest Thing Made in Wisconsin" contest. Senator Patrick Testin (Stevens Point), who each year suggests a product made in the 24th District for consideration, has nominated KI Mobility's Ethos wheelchair for this year's contest.
