Senator Testin Will Lead Senate Committee on Health

Madison, WI – Senator Patrick Testin (Stevens Point) will continue to chair the Senate Committee on Health according to a Tuesday announcement from Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu (Oostburg). Senator Testin will also assume leadership roles on two other committees, serving as Co-Chair of the Joint Survey Committee on Tax Exemptions, and as Vice-Chairman of the Senate Committee on Economic & Workforce Development.

"I'm honored to continue as Chairman of the Senate Committee on Health," said Testin. "Last session, I worked with my colleagues to improve access to quality care, increase price transparency, and introduce more options for patients. I'm committed to building on that record moving forward."

In addition, Senator Testin will once again represent Central and Western Wisconsin on the Senate Committee on Agriculture and Tourism, and will be a member of the Joint Information Policy and Technology Committee. He will serve on an interim basis on the Senate Housing, Commerce, and Trade Committee.
