To the Honorable Members of Wisconsin's Congressional Delegation:

As Senators and Representatives representing thousands of constituents across our state, and elected officials who care about the livelihoods of every Wisconsinite and the health of our democracy, we write today with a deep sense of alarm about the Trump Administration's recent actions and their impact on everyday Americans.

Our constituents have shared grave concerns regarding Elon Musk, an unappointed and unelected individual, violating the privacy and threatening the security of millions of Americans' personal data and financial information. Beyond Elon Musk's clear conflicts of interest, as his businesses hold billions of dollars of federal contracts, it should trouble every elected official that he and his team of unelected private citizens have unfettered access to Americans' personal data without transparency or oversight.

We urge you to support Congressman Pocan's ELON MUSK Act to prevent Elon Musk from abusing his power as a special government employee and rigging the federal government to line his own pockets. No unelected billionaire should have control of the U.S. Treasury Department's highly sensitive information.

Furthermore, the Trump Administration continues to supplant the powers and duties that our US Constitution reserves for Congress. From President Trump's dangerous and unconstitutional power grab, freezing billions of already allocated federal dollars for local Wisconsin programs, to the abrupt and illegal cuts to USAID, to his attacks on federal agencies and civil servants, Congress cannot allow his attacks on our separation of powers – the bedrock of our democracy – to continue.

Over the last few weeks, we have heard from constituents, local governments, businesses, schools, and nonprofits across our state about the devastating impacts of the Trump administration's barrage of reckless acts. We echo their demands: follow and enforce the rule of law, prosecute those who have broken federal law, and exercise congressional powers and oversight. Rather than enabling these power grabs and political stunts, focus on issues that most impact Wisconsinites and Americans, from lowering costs and fighting inflation to expanding affordable healthcare and improving our public schools.

We applaud the efforts of Senator Baldwin, Congressman Pocan, and Congresswoman Moore to combat the dangerous and irresponsible actions of President Trump's administration, and we implore each of Wisconsin's federal representatives to take action and stand up for the Constitution and for the safety and wellbeing of every American and our country as a whole.


