Hesselbein & Neubauer Respond to Republican Proposal Making Abortion Less Accessible

MADISON, Wis – Today, the State Assembly will hold a public hearing on [Assembly Bill 975](#) (AB 975), which would significantly roll back abortion access if approved. Senate Democratic Leader Dianne Hesselbein (D-Middleton) and Assembly Democratic Leader Greta Neubauer (D-Racine) released the following statement:

“Today marks the 51st Anniversary of the monumental Supreme Court ruling, *Roe v. Wade*, protecting a person’s constitutional right to choose. Unfortunately, that right was stripped away from millions of people when right-wing extremists on the US Supreme Court overturned *Roe* in 2022. Now, Wisconsin Republicans are again attempting to roll back abortion access.

“Time and time again, election after election, Wisconsinites have made it abundantly clear: they do not want politicians involved in their personal health decisions. Any proposal that makes abortion more difficult to access, including the one before us today, is a nonstarter. Legislative Democrats will never stop fighting to make sure Wisconsinites can make their own reproductive healthcare decisions.”
