## 2025 BILL

1     **AN ACT to create** 74.09 (3) (gb) of the statutes; **relating to:** including with the  
2             property tax bill information about state aid reduction to school districts.

*Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill requires that a person's property tax bill include information from the school district where the property is located regarding the amount of any gross reduction in state aid to the district as a result of pupils enrolled in the statewide parental choice program, the Racine Parental Choice Program, or the Milwaukee Parental Choice Program or as a result of making payments to private schools under the Special Needs Scholarship Program.

2 and the current year and the percentage change between those years, except that  
3 this paragraph does not apply in any year in which such a reduction does not occur.

4 2. In addition to the information provided under subd. 1., include the  
5 following insert in substantially similar form:

6 “The gross reduction in state aid to your school district in the .... (current year)  
7 is \$ .... as a result of pupils enrolled in the .... (statewide choice program) (Racine  
8 choice program) (Milwaukee choice program) or as a result of payments to .... (a  
9 private school) under the special needs scholarship program. Your school district  
10 had the option to increase property taxes to replace this aid reduction.”
